Florence/Pisa/Tuscany (Livorno), Italy

The architectural and artistic masterpieces of the Renaissance await you in Florence, a masterpiece in itself. Pisa's superb Field of Miracles and iconic Leaning Tower also beckon, as does the captivating Tuscan countryside, renowned for its gently rolling hills and splendid wine.

Olbia/Porto Cervo, Sardinia, Italy

Ajaccio, Corsica, France
