PORTS OF CALL

Eden, Australia

On the Sapphire Coast of New South Wales, overlooking Twofold Bay—a playground for a variety of whale species—Eden is surrounded by pretty beaches and the rugged scenery of Ben Boyd National Park.

Melbourne, Australia

With a rich history and distinctly European flavor, Melbourne is a cultural mecca distinguished by Victorian architecture and myriad museums and galleries. Nearby, the Healesville Sanctuary is considered the best place to view Australian wildlife.

Burnie, Tasmania, Australia

A delightful port with an industrial past, Burnie has recast itself into a vibrant and creative city. Popular attractions include Pioneer Village Museum; the Makers Workshop; the stunning Rhododendron Garden; and Fern Glade Reserve, perfect for a peaceful stroll along the Emu River.

Cruising the Fjords of Milford Sound

Breathtakingly beautiful, this legendary fjord is an incredible natural spectacle of cascading waterfalls, swaths of rainforest clinging to towering cliffs, and massive peaks rising vertically from serene waters.

Dunedin, New Zealand

On the southeast coast of New Zealand's South Island, Dunedin blends past and present, nature and culture from its perch on verdant hills overlooking a magnificent harbor.

Akaroa, New Zealand

Cradled within the serrated coastline of the Banks Peninsula is the small fishing town of Akaroa, meaning “long harbor” in Maori. The town's European past is recalled in lovely architecture and winding streets appointed with elegant French names.

Nelson, New Zealand

Hailed as one of New Zealand's most liveable cities, Nelson is a magnet for artists and nature lovers, with its golden beaches, virgin forests, and rugged mountains. Explore this easygoing city of art galleries and workshops, waterfront cafes, and boutique wineries, or head inland to Takaka to discover New Zealand's largest freshwater springs.

Wellington, New Zealand

The political center of New Zealand, Wellington is home to the Parliament Buildings, National Archives, and the National Library. The city is also celebrated for its plentiful shops, restaurants, and galleries. The Museum of New Zealand Te Papa Tongarewa traces New Zealand's history, environment, art, and Maori heritage.

Napier, New Zealand

Irresistibly delightful, Napier features the shore-hugging Marine Parade and the stingray-shaped National Aquarium of New Zealand. Nearby Port Ahuriri marks the first European settlement in the region.

Tauranga/Rotorua, New Zealand

In the aptly named Bay of Plenty is picturesque Tauranga, home to the Elms Mission House, one of the country's oldest homes. Just south of Tauranga is the popular town of Rotorua, a geothermal paradise with hot springs, bubbling mud pools, and gushing geysers.
