Neither GN nor the American Queen Steamboat Company (hereinafter AQSC) nor the sponsoring association are responsible for any penalty, loss or inconvenience resulting from air or land arrangements made independently by travelers, including non-refundable conditions, restricted travel or frequent flyer tickets.

PAYMENT: A deposit in the amount shown on the reservation form and a signed agreement for each person is required to secure reservations. Final payment is due as shown on the reservation form.

PRICES: GN RESERVES THE RIGHT TO INCREASE PRICES IN THE EVENT OF ANY INCREASED SECURITY OR FUEL RELATED SURCHARGES, OR FARE INCREASES IMPOSED BY THE AIRLINE OR CRUISE LINE THAT MAY BE IN PLACE AT THE TIME OF TICKETING OR TRAVEL, FOREIGN OR DOMESTIC TAX INCREASES, OR ADVERSE CURRENCY EXCHANGE FLUCTUATIONS, AFTER JANUARY 01, 2016. AQSC is required to provide all guests' ID information including ID number, expiration date, and place of issue to the Coast Guard and/or other government entities prior to the vessel's departure. Guests must provide this information to AQSC in advance. Travel documents will not be released until received. Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada entering the U.S. are required to bring their passport. For other nationalities, passports are required to enter the U.S. It is your responsibility to check with your local U.S. embassy/consulate to confirm visa requirements and to obtain the proper visa/U.S. alien card (green card).

AQSC'S LAND PACKAGES/SHORE EXCURSIONS: Tours are operated in the various ports of call by AQSC or local tourist service companies contracted by the cruise line. They are not under the control of GN. Cancellation penalties may differ from the cruise program related penalties. AQSC may modify the cruise itinerary up to and during the voyage.



OCTOBER 29: PADUCAH, KENTUCKY

Arrive 12PM—Depart 5PM

Founded by William Clark following his westward journey with Meriwether Lewis, Paducah bears the name of an Indian chief and the legacy of a Union supply hub on the Tennessee and Ohio Rivers during the Civil War.

INCLUDED EXCURSION A tour of Paducah brings you to the National Quilt Museum, the Lowertown Arts District, the Lloyd Tilghman House and Civil War Museum, the Paducah Railroad Museum, and the River Discovery Center.

OCTOBER 30: NEW MADRID, MISSOURI

Arrive 8AM—Depart 1PM

The oldest city west of the Mississippi, New Madrid is famous for enduring powerful earthquakes in the early 1800s and for the Civil War's Battle of Island Number Ten. Boasting a storied past, this Missouri city retains the Southern charm it's held since the last days of the 1700s.

INCLUDED EXCURSION Stop at the New Madrid Observation Deck, offering stunning views of Bessie Bend; the New Madrid Historical Museum; the New Madrid County Courthouse; the Hunter-Dawson State Historic Site; the primitive Higginson Schoolhouse; and the Hart-Stepp House Art Gallery, housed in New Madrid's oldest home.

OCTOBER 31: MEMPHIS, TENNESSEE

Arrive 8AM
